Goal of NIPN: Evidence-informed nutrition policies and programmes

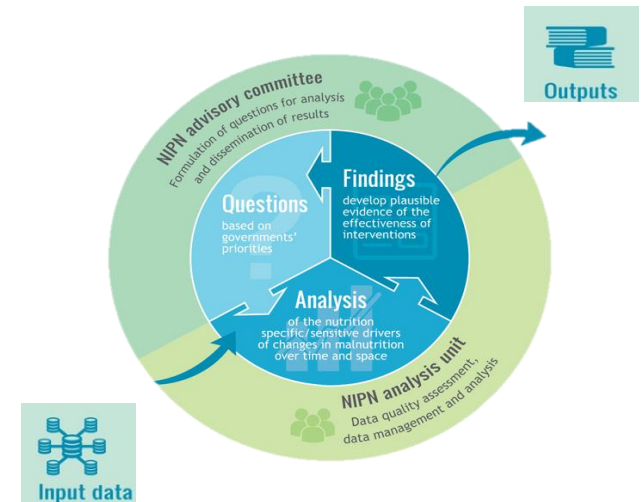
OBJECTIVES

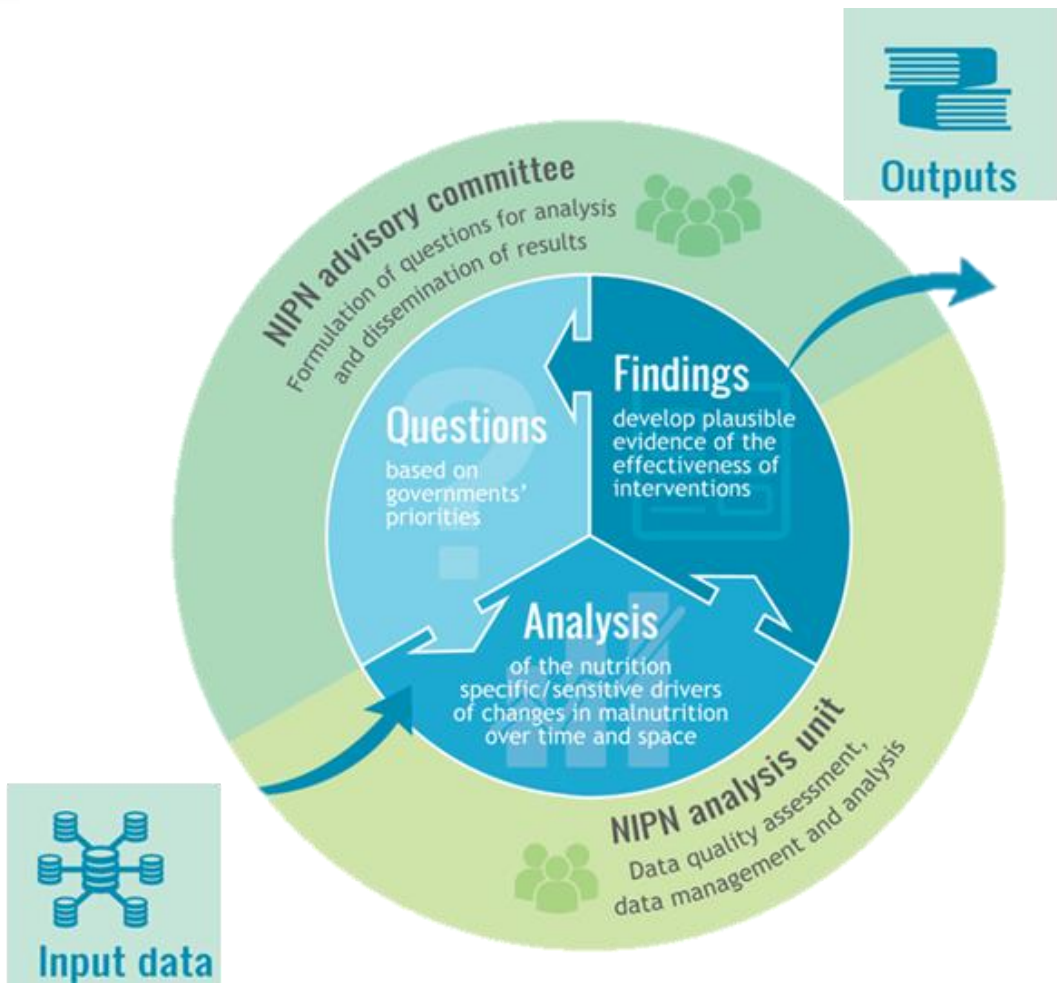
1. To create country-led and country-owned multi-sectoral National Information Platforms for Nutrition
2. To manage and analyse information and data from all sectors with an influence on nutrition
3. To disseminate and use information, informing strategic policy and programme decisions on nutrition



3-steps NIPN process

1. Raise nutrition policy questions
2. Compile existing information to answer these questions, analyse data and interpret results
3. Feed findings into nutrition policy dialogue

Country-led and -owned	Experience in working across multiple sectors



Moving from R1 to R2 to R3

R1: Country NIPN has capacity to operate and maintain NIPN

R2: Country tracks progress on nutrition

R3: Country feeds NIPN findings into nutrition policies

R4: global technical support and engagement

- From setting up (R1) to implementation (R2)
- Shifting to country responsibility
- Shifting roles on technical support

Formulating nutrition policy questions

Identify data availability and quality

Analyse data and present findings

Feed findings into policy dialogue

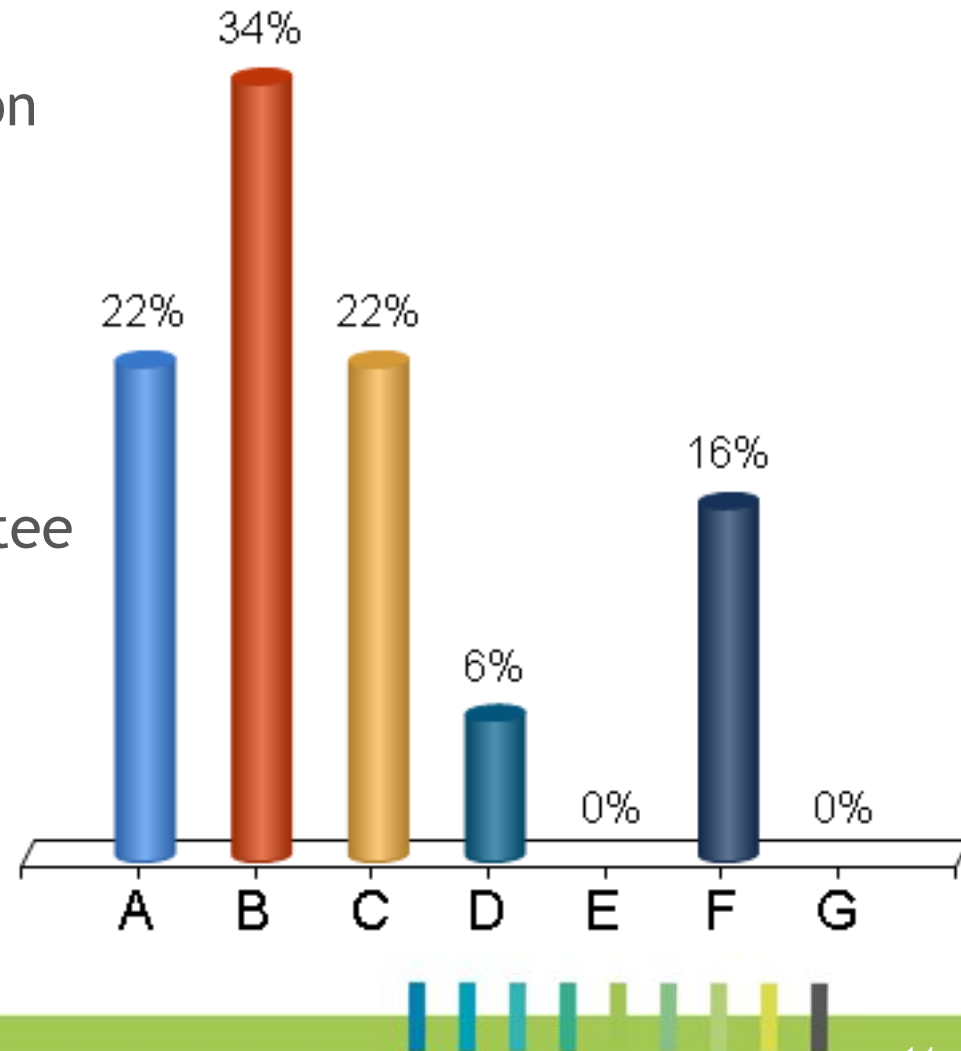

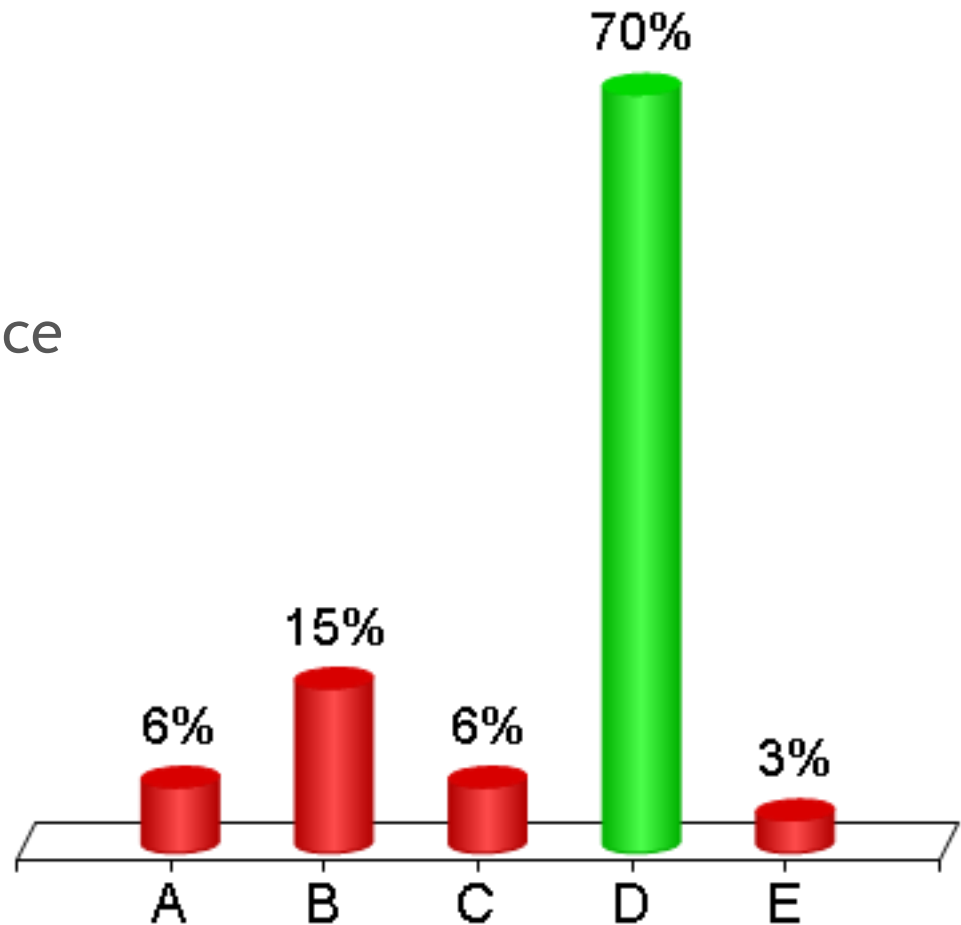
