

ASSETS FOR SUSTAINABILITY

- UGP (Management Unit) rooted in the Permanent
 Technical Secretariat of the National Council for
 Nutrition (STP-CNN), which is directly attached to the
 Prime Minister's Office
- Management Unit (UGP) made up of 5 people working full time on the PNMIN and paid by the State of Ivory Coast.
- Activities of the platform integrated into the STP-CNN operational action plan.

ASSETS FOR SUSTAINABILITY

- Operation of the PNMIN integrated into the STP-CNN procedures manual.
- Operational expenditure for the PNMIN integrated into the STP-CNN budget (staff salaries, premises, transport and communications costs, social security)



POTENTIAL CHALLENGES TO ANTICIPATE...

- Support from stakeholders (STP-CANN,
 Technical Committee of the National Council
 for Nutrition, Regional Nutrition Committees,
 National Institute for Statistics).
- Future funding for PNMIN activities.
- Staff motivation.
- Regular updating of the centralized directory.



PROBABLE SOLUTIONS...

- Keep the PNMIN rooted at a high institutional level.
- Strengthen the capacities of the PNMIN team.
- Think about alternative sources of post-project funding (State budget, ideally...).
- Establish a long-term mechanism for centralizing sector data.
