## Context and justification

- Ivory Coast has a National Multi-sectoral Nutrition Plan 2016-2020 with 7 strategic priorities; strategic priority 7 (an environment that is favorable to nutrition is created and governance is strengthened) has been entrusted to the **Permanent Technical Secretariat of the National Council for Nutrition (STP-CNN)**, the structure which is home to the PNMIN in Ivory Coast.
- This priority aims to establish a reliable and effective monitoring and evaluation system.



## Context and justification

- Therefore, a Common Monitoring and Evaluation Framework (CCSE) has been drawn up, producing a list of 141 indicators from 13 sectors.
- The STP-CNN is assisted in this task by the PNMIN, whose objectives are:
- to contribute to strengthening national capacity to centralize, manage and analyze information and data from all sectors that have an influence on nutrition;

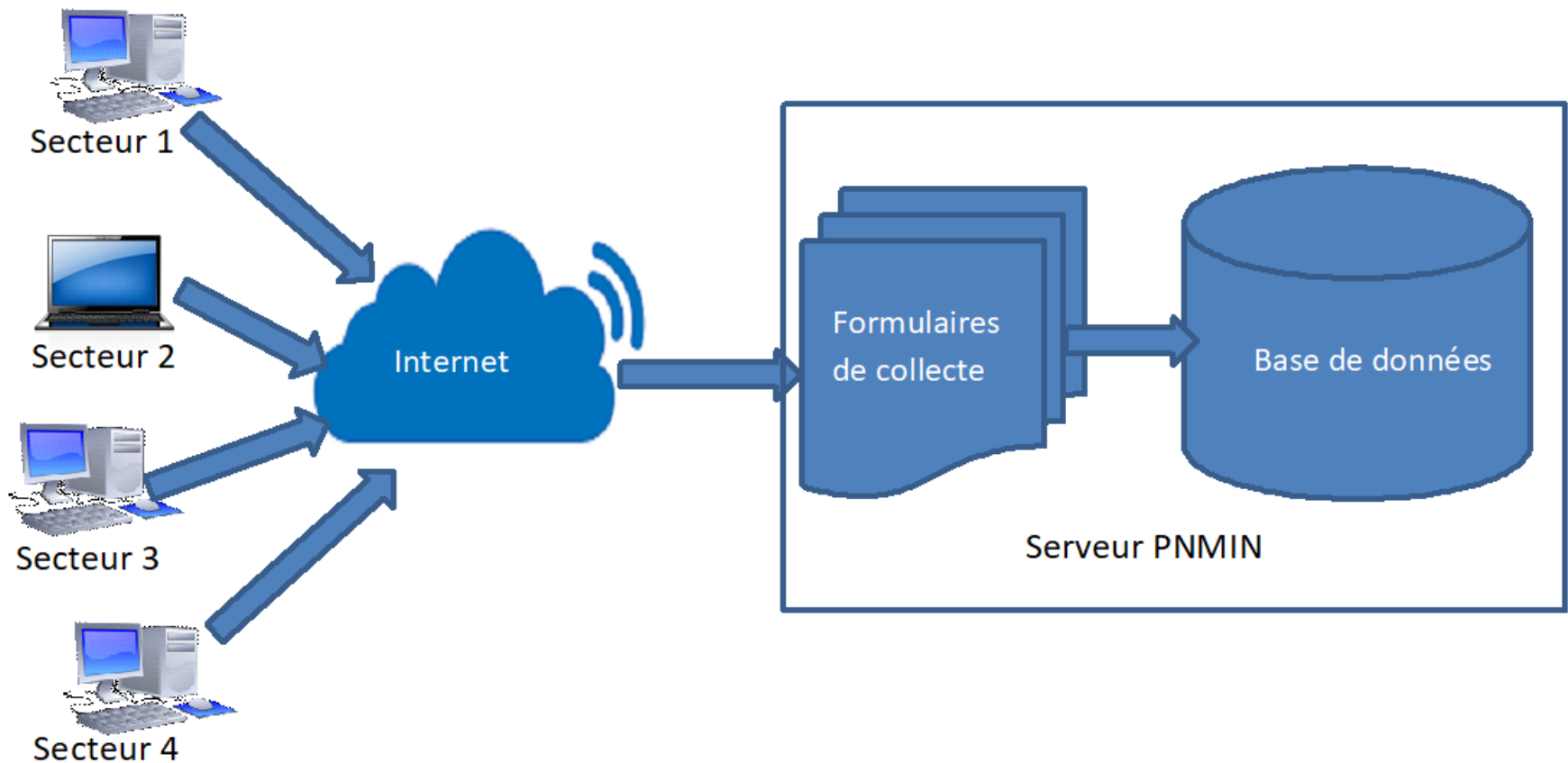
- and to disseminate and use information to better guide the country in decision-making to prevent malnutrition and its consequences.
- It is in this context that the PNMIN is establishing a centralized data directory.



## Objectives of the PNMIN centralized directory

- To make all multi-sectoral nutritional indicators, data and metadata available to decision-makers, researchers and all those involved, in a single, user-friendly tool.
- To archive nutritional information (policy documents, plans, programmes, survey reports, etc.)


