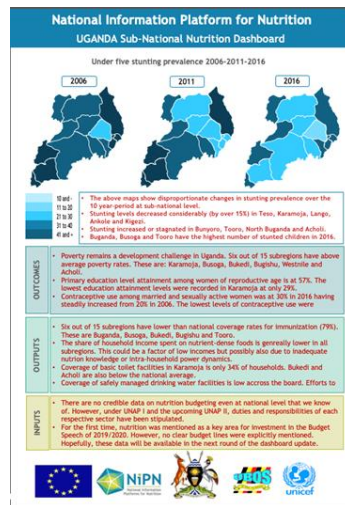

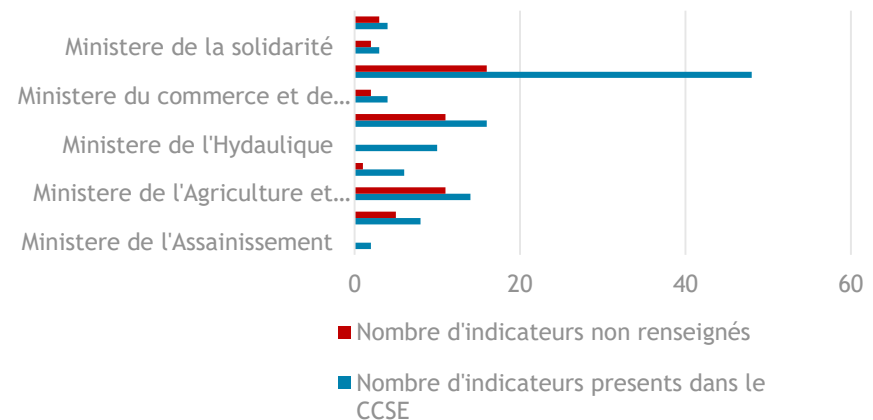

# NIPN & Covid / NIPN & emerging topics

**How does the Ivory Coast NIPN support the response to Corona Virus crisis information needs?**

**The Government Response Plan**

1. Covering immediate food & nutrition needs for vulnerable population / hospitals / prisons
2. Improve access to food and resilience of food producers
3. Promoting good hygiene and feeding practices
4. Coordination and monitoring of the implementation of the response plan

**AND**

**NIPN platform operates under the Prime Minister Office Of Ivory Coast**

**The NIPN platform's responsibilities, in coordination with 5 key Ministries:**

- Collect monitoring data from daily update meetings
- Centralize and analyze this information
- Disseminate and use information for better guide government response
- Track progress on the Plan's implementation
- Support MoH to monitor new cases of malnutrition attributed to COVID-19
- Update and publish related information on dedicated website.

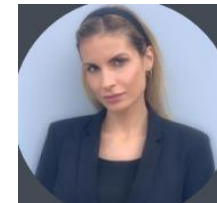

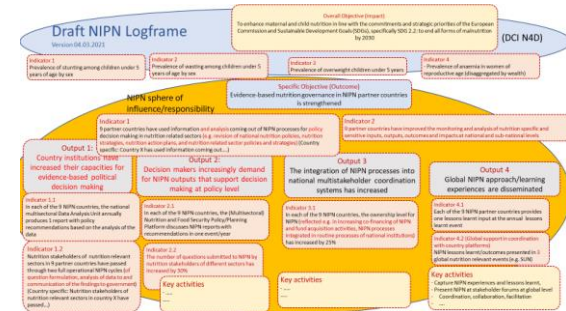
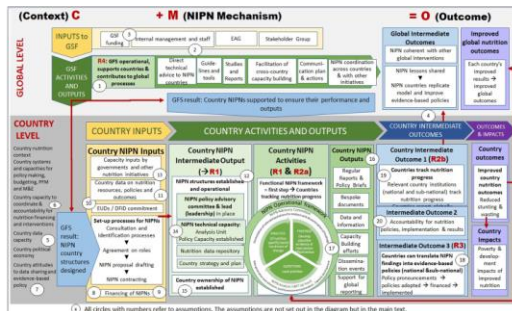
